The bulk of this one page report should be taken up by a description of the challenges your team faced while coding and how you overcame them.

Last but not least, you should try to convince us about what makes your project unique, and why your team deserves to win.

The report will account for 30% of your final evaluation.

## **Submission**

This report should be typed and submitted as a .pdf file along with your code and your instruction manual by **11:59:59pm Eastern Time on Saturday May 13th, 2023**.
